Recently arrived, this colourful little vanity bag - 'chanteh' in Persian - with its myriad of 8-pointed stars in fabulous shades of vegetable madder-red, indigo-blue, green, yellow, aubergine and natural undyed ivory. Made by Qashqa'i tribes in south-western Persia circa 1860-1870, the bag is complete with original plain-weave back and braided selvedges. I love the single 8-pointed star on the back which the weaver must have inserted as a symbol of protection! Size: 31cm x 33cm (12" x 13").
