This stunning half saddle-bag face is charming with its depiction of stylised cockerels - the symbolic harbinger of the day - dispeller of the night! The indigo-blue field is glowing and I love the central ivory bird - the male - and around it the dark-coloured females. Made by Timuri tribes in western Afghanistan during the second half of the 19th century, the bag is in very good pile but needs a good wash. The already replaced selvages require replacing with better quality side-cords. Size: 66cm x 74cm (2' 2" x 2' 5").
