The pretty dial is enamel on copper with delicately painted floral swags between the numbers and blued steel hands. The French movement is of high quality and is in excellent clean and running condition having been fully overhauled by our clockmaker. Mercury compensated pendulum is original and is designed to compensate for the effects of temperature. It runs for 8 days and strikes the hours and halves on a coiled gong.
