Description

A gents 1914 WW1 silver trench watch. The watch has a Swiss hand-winding movement which is ticking away nicely and the time keeping is good to within around two to three minutes over 24 hours. The jewelled movement is stamped Swiss Made. The watch measures 32.4 mm diameter excluding the winding crown and the fixed wire lugs. The case is sterling silver and there are import marks inside the case back for London 1914, with the importers mark LW (Louis Weill). The case has light surface marking to the front and mild denting to the back but overall the condition is good for a WW1 piece. The watch lens is glass and is in nice condition. The watch has an enamel dial which is in nice condition. It has its original blued steel hands (the sub second hand is later). The watch has a new brown leather strap.
