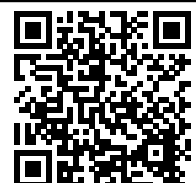

The inside of the lid of the case bears the retailer's mark for top notch Scottish silversmith, McInnes Brothers of Glasgow, with a Royal Warrant to the Prince of Wales. The blades of each knife is beautifully decorated with an engraved fish amongst a variety of marine foliage. The top of the case is mounted with a sterling silver presentation plaque with the silversmith's initials for McInnes Brothers and an engraved presentation message dated 1885.
