A rare example of 18th Century table silver. This lovely piece is in the sought after Onslow pattern and is a spice sifting spoon. In the 18th century and into the early 19th, spices were considered exotic and were expensive - indicating wealth and status. They were served at the table and a spice sifting spoon was used for delicate distribution. P&P contribution :- £7.00 UK £12.00 Worldwide. Condition :- Excellent, with no dents or splits. Hallmarks :- Only Maker's mark present (not unusual for early pieces of small flatware.) Date :- c1780. Maker :- John Lambe. Length :- 11 cms. Bowl diameter :- 3.25 cms.
