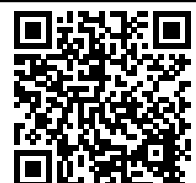
The patina on this beautifully shaped sewing box is quite wonderful, over 200 years has given the red leather a rich dark colour, the leather still with a soft sheen. The red leather is embossed inside and out. The box has some exquisite brass fittings, enhancing it's exquisite shape. The front has a large brass escutcheon which houses the working tasselled key. Each side has a typically Regency handle in the form of a large urn filled with flowers complimenting the grand Lion's paw feet. The interior is totally original with a typically Regency blue coloured paper and velvet, the interior of the lid is hand-painted onto the velvet and surrounded by gold embossed paper. This can be opened to reveal a secret compartment where letters and papers would be kept safe. The box came to me as is, with all sorts of bits and bobs and are included.
