With four shaped drop leaves which when raised make the table into a clover leaf shape and having four concealed sliding counter wells. Supported on four turned and fluted columns united by carved and fluted stretchers and with swept walnut feet and brass and porcelain castors. English circa 1870 Dimensions: 20" wide x 20" deep x 28" high (Opened 36" wide x 26" deep) Filmer & Son was established by Thomas Henry Filmer, a cabinet-maker, upholsterer and appraiser first recorded at 34 Berners Street in 1835.
