I love the archaic feel of this unusual Turkmen Engsi with the border of 'tamgans' (eagles) and the extra wide panels at the base of the rug. Dating to circa 1880 and made by Tekke weavers, this Engsi was originally intended as a door hanging on the inside of the Turkmen yurt. This is a superb example from the late 19th century in near-mint condition. Size: 1.60m x 1.27m (5' 3" x 4' 2").
