Having gilt slip and housed in the original birds eye maple frames English circa 1839 Dimensions: 23" high x 26" wide Henry Thomas Alken (12 October 1785 – 7 April 1851) was an English painter and engraver chiefly known as a caricaturist and illustrator of sporting subjects and coaching scenes. His most prolific period of painting and drawing occurred between 1816 and 1831.
