The folding handle and lid are made from silver plate and the underside of the lid signed by the top notch silversmith, Mappin & Webb of London and Sheffield. The top of the lid is beautifully engraved with a floral and foliate design. My silversmith found me a period spoon to complete the offering. Excellent condition with the widest diameter of the glass measuring 3 1/2" standing 4 1/4" to rim of jar and 6 1/2" tall while the handle is upright. Item ID: 36559
