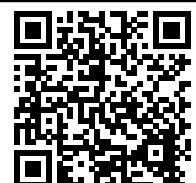
This interesting Turkmen Torba (small storage bag) is unusually coloured, with a good proportion of steel-blue and dark indigo-blue as well as highlights of golden-yellow. The 'gols' form a tile pattern in a compartmentalised design and these variations, some of them extremely rare, are represented by several examples in Robert Pinner's 'Turkmen Studies'. I believe this torba belongs to a sub-tribe of the Yomut and is of a rare design group. Size: 89cm x 35cm (3' 0" x 1' 2").
