The spoons and forks are made by the master silversmiths Elkington & Co, and the knives and fish eaters (octagonal pistol-grip design) are of later (UNUSED, still in their original "tarnish-proof" cutlery rolls) manufacture, having the benefit of being hard-soldered, which means they can be cleaned in a dish washer.
