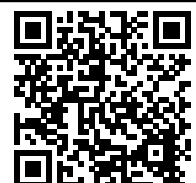

English, Circa 1900 Ruskin Pottery was founded in 1898 by Edward R. Taylor and run by his son William in West Midlands of England. It was named after the writer artist John Ruskin.
