A fine quality, quite early Swiss MUSIC BOX by David Lecoultré, and signed with his monogram on the comb. Within its original walnut case, the excellent quality key-wound movement plays EIGHT tunes on its perfect comb which contains 102 teeth. The tone and variety of the tunes are impressive, and the box is complete with its original key and hand-written tune sheet affixed to the inside of the lid. Measurements ~ the box: 20ins wide; 6.5ins deep; the cylinder 13ins wide. (51 x 16.5cms; cylinder: 33cms) ** David Lecoultré established a factory in Geneva in 1810, at first making watches and later specialising in music boxes. He is known to be responsible for many of the important improvements that can be found on good quality music boxes.
