Nice shaping to the top of the door and original bracket feet. The horn top with original brass patera and original eagle and ball in the centre. The 8 day movement was made by John Christie himself thus is of better quality than normal mass produced Birmingham movements. The painted dial with a village scene to the top with conch shells in the corners. The original pendulum also painted with a conch shell. This clock is all original. The movement has been fully cleaned and serviced and comes with a 1 year guarantee. SIZES; Maximum height is 87". Maximum width is 19".
