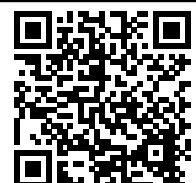

The base is a heavy rose coloured polished brass with thick rope mounts. The inkwell is made from Wedgwood Jasperware with classical scenes. Once the lid is opened to reveal the removable ink chamber made from the original frosted glass with the polished brass rim engraved by the retailer " Vincent Goldsmith Weymouth".
