An arched pediment with inlays and Corinthian capped fluted columns. Chamfered trunk sides. An early example of a painted dial with raised gilt corners. Date and seconds dials with lunar moon phases to the arch with a sailing frigate. An 8-day duration mechanism striking the hours on a bell. Edward Powell of Bristol is well documented in AJ Moores 'Clockmakers of Bristol' book. He worked at the Exchange from 1792-1825. Height 7ft 6 " / 229cms.
