A fine quality antique mahogany continental cabinet dating from circa 1830 in a Biedermeier influenced design. The oblong top with curved front corners above a beaded panelled door enclosing five sliding oak trays and on curved bracket feet. Of North European manufacture, possibly Belgium or French it was most likely originally used as a sheet music cabinet. A versatile, functional and attractive piece, all the slide out shelves will come out, so it could easily be adapted for storage of larger items.
