Description

Nora Summers (1892-1948) - Oil On Canvas Red Tulips in a Lustre Jug. Provenance - Sally Hunter Fine Art , London , No 43 in Nora Summers Exhibition 1998 from the state of the Artist purchased by David Abbot Esq February 1998. Through her art Nora Summers sought a personal vision of Arcadia. She was receptive to the bucolic spirit of the artistic circles in which she moved, and absorbed something of the vivid Post-Impressionism of J.D. Innes, Augustus John and Derwent Lees. Her work often has a sense of hermetic stillness: of frozen time, of unemphatic yet implicit personal allegory. Nora went to Bristol School of Art before enrolling at the Slade School in London where she studied under the formidable Henry Tonks from 1907-1910. She became friendly with J.D. Innes and Derwent Lees and met a fellow student, Gerald Summers (1886-1969), whom she married in September 1912 at Chelsea Old Church. From 1914, Nora became a frequent visitor to Augustus John's extended household at Alderney Manor overlooking the Purbecks in Dorset. There she photographed the John and Macnamara children while forging lifelong links with both families, especially Yvonne Macnamara, who became for No...
