It has an accommodating dished elm seat supported by well turned legs united by a double H-stretcher. The scrolling arms are supported by smaller turned uprights and the chair's elegant lathe-back is surmounted by a gently bowed bar back. This handsome high quality Victorian Windsor chair is English, and it dates from c.1880s. . .
