Pair of early C19th Regency period 'Grecian-revival' style mahogany chairs. Stylish pair of side chairs of classically-referenced design, with classical Grecian motif carving, featuring acanthus, lotus and palmettes. The shaped lumbar-support splat with a central tablet. Probably influenced by the drawings and designs of Thomas Hope and Charles Heathcote-Tatham, inspired by the architecture from the ancient classical Empires of Rome, Greece and Egypt. Standing on reeded fore-legs, the back with a stylish deeply-raked angle. Original mellow green hide upholstery to seats. One chair with old repairs to top-rail.
