## Antique English silver pocket, Inglis & Sons, York

## Description

An antique English silver pocket watch originally retailed by Inglis & Sons of York. The watch has a stem-winding  $\frac{3}{4}$  plate movement which is working nicely and has a good strong beat; the timekeeping is good to within around two to three minutes over 24 hours. The movement is signed Inglis & Sons, York, and it is protected by an inner hinged dust cover. The watch measures 47mm diameter excluding the winding stem and the loop. The case is silver and there are hallmarks inside both of the back covers for London 1913, with a maker's mark for the Coventry and London based Rotherham & Sons. The case back has rather elaborate initials. The watch glass looks good to the naked eye; there is light marking if you look closely. The signed enamel dial is in good order and has blued steel hands (initially set by way of the pin set mechanism), a subsidiary seconds dial and an outer minute track.
