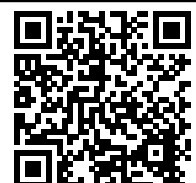

The lid is made from solid English sterling silver hallmarked for Birmingham 1935 with a gilded interior; the knob on the top is silver gilt and is also hallmarked. The makers initials, AC, are also present for the silversmith, Albert Carter of Birmingham. The enamel is a stunning blue colour with a shiny patina, showcasing the intricate engine turning below.
