Description

A delightful, pretty and fine quality early/mid 19th century MANTLE or TABLE CLOCK of small size and of "Four-Glass" type. The rosewood case is gorgeous, with its gadrooned gabled top with cast brass handle and fluted decoration above the front door which is flanked by canted corners inlaid in brass whilst the whole clock is supported on squat bun feet. The eight-day movement is gut-driven fusee, with its original platform lever escapement, whilst the dial is engraved & silvered and signed by the maker: Thomas Hunt, Tottenham Court Road (London). **Thomas Hunt is recorded as a good maker of watches and chronometers 1822-1835.
