The back and the top border of the chair are decorated with an inlaid geometric border and carvings forming an arch which encloses a central panel inlaid with a primitive floral design. The chair has broad shepherds crook arms and stout turned legs at the front with a carved frieze. The chair is in good condition for its age, there is little shrinkage in the back causing a thin separation of the wooden panel. The chair back is 40" high, the front is 23" wide and the seat is 18" high.
