Description

A fine quality mahogany stick barometer. The rectangular silvered brass scale is calibrated from 27" to 31" and features a sliding vernier with a brass pointer. The integral thermometer is calibrated from -10° to 120° Fahrenheit and is also engraved with the makers name, place of work and the typical weather indications used at this period. The mahogany case has an exposed mercury tube, with a turned cistern cover to the base. The glazed access door is surmounted with an architectural pediment and a central brass finial. Both the access door and trunk of the case are inlaid with ebony and boxwood stringing. Note: Jacopi of Salop is listed as working between 1800-1840. Salop being the old spelling of Shrewsbury in the county of Shropshire.
