This was presented in 1919 by the crew of the HMS Clacton Belle, a minesweeper from the first world war to Lt F A Robbins. It measures; Length 12" x Width 5" and height 11". The bottles and casing are all in excellent condition. We have included a picture of a postcard showing the Clacton Belle before she was enlisted in the first world war. A truly lovely thing to own.
