Pair of C19th 'red-ware' pottery ewers after the antique in Ancient Greek style. Elegant pair of ewers of tapering amphora-bodied form with shaped spouts and loop handles. The bodies decorated with a band of classical-style incised decoration. Modelled after vases from antiquity, probably produced in Italy to cater for the fashionable demand during this period, for classical objects from the ancient Empires. Fired terracotta bodies with high polish finish, resonant of 'Rosso Antico' marble. No damage or restoration. H 16" W 5" Italy c.1850
