In mint condition, this tiny vanity-bag must have been a highly-prized possession amongst the Qashqa'i nomads. The face in knotted-pile with a group of 5 motifs - symbolising protection - and the back in narrow horizontal bands of natural-dye colours. Note the flat-woven lappits at the top in order that the goat-hair cords could be thread through and the bag secured. Size: 28cm x 25cm (11" x 10").
