We are offering for sale this Scottish painting on canvas by the artist Angus Cameron, who has signed the painting in the lower right hand corner. > The painting depicts a loch view, with some sheep grazing on the slopes leading down to the water. The banks of the loch are heavily forested and in the foreground is a path leading between some silver birch trees, with a small burn rushing over the rocks. > This is one of a pair of paintings by the artist we are listing. > Unfortunately, Angus Cameron is a very common name and, as we do not have a birth date to go on, it has been impossible to find him in Census records or births. > It does not appear that he exhibited in London, as he is not listed in the major artists' directories, but there are a few auction records for his work. Two cattle oil paintings of his were sold by Christie's New York in 2012 for £956 and 1 by Bonhams Chelsea in 1995 for £1,050. > The painting is framed in a 2" contemporary gilt frame and will be supplied wired and ready to hang. > Frame size 27 1/4" x 19 1/4" - 69.2cm x 48.8cm > Medium Oils on Windsor and Newton canvas > Condition The condition is good. There are no repairs to the canvas ...
