An exceptional 19th century library bookcase in burr walnut. This top quality example – made by the highly respected cabinetmakers Holland & Sons of London (suppliers to many Royal households including Windsor Castle) and with the impressed maker's stamp to the top of the right hand door – is comprised of a straight-moulded overhanging cornice with a double open bookcase below, each with four walnut-lipped adjustable-height shelves. The two left hand doors conceal a wide cupboard interior with a full-width adjustable shelf, and behind the right hand door is a similarly arranged compartment. This very fine bookcase is of the highest quality; it has its original finish with a beautifully rich, warm colour, and there are working keys to the original door locks.
