The tops and front beautifully inlaid with a boxwood and ebony chequer line, and boxwood and ebony stars. The table stands on square legs with the original leather barrel castors with fretted brackets all round. There are drawers and a slide to the front. All the brasswork is also original. The tops fold out to reveal a fully fitted interior with a fully adjustable mirror to the centre which as well as being adjustable with a ratchet behind also slides forwards and backwards the whole width of the table.
