Well-carved splat back , carved terminals to the ends of back , and carved cabriole legs fitted with original brass castors, splayed rear supports with original brass castors. Very stylish chair taking its inspiration from the Ancient Greek classical "Klismos" chair . No breaks or repairs, cleaned and waxed . The seat also having been re-webbed .
