Description

A very fine quality French early 19th century Empire period mantle CLOCK in perfect working order. This handsome clock is of white marble and Belgian slate, embellished with ormolu mounts which include an eagle within the pediment; a fountain; an urn of flowers and fruit and a flamingo, whilst there is an ormolu panel of dancing putti to the base. The 8-day movement has silk suspension and strikes hours and half-hours via the outside countwheel, on a bell. The enamel dial is perfect as are the delightful ormolu hands. Signed: Deschamp a Paris to the dial. 15ins wide; 13.5ins high maximum (38 x 34.25 cms). *The Deschamps family were a successful and highly regarded family of Paris clockmakers. Clocks were signed as here from 1823-1853.
