Door at the base for inserting the pendulum. The circular 11" white enamelled dial signed J Harrison Darlington, with good quality original blued steel hands. The high quality, fully restored, 8 day twin fusee movement with shaped plates, united by 5 pillars, striking the hours on a single bell. The original brass pendulum with nicely detailed edges to the brass rod. Overall an excellent 100% original clock in fine condition with good patina and colour.
