Description

A charming early 19th century mahogany WRITING or CHAMBER TABLE, in excellent condition. The well figured top with its rounded corners, is cross-banded in rosewood between ebony and boxwood stringing. To the front is a long mahogany-lined drawer, whilst the sides and back have false drawers, thus making this table fully free-standing. It is supported on "standard" ends inlaid with ebony stringing and united by a turned stretcher, leading to sabre legs and the set of four very good original brass castors. * Possibly by Trotter of Edinburgh, who often used the "beehive" motif seen here to the centre of the stretcher.

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
