Description

An antique silver fusee pocket watch. The watch has a key wound fusee (chain driven) movement which is ticking away nicely and the time keeping is good to within around two minutes or so over 24 hours. The movement is signed with the name of the Cheshire watchmaker Thomas Maddock, Frodsham, and it is protected by an inner fitted cover. The watch measures 50mm diameter excluding the stem and the loop. The case is silver and both of the back covers have hallmarks for London 1865 together with a maker's mark for the Coventry based watch case maker Frederick Wilkins. The case is in good condition for its age with just the odd mark and rubbing to the engine turned detail on the case back. The plastic lens is in good condition. The off-white dial is in lovely condition and the hands are a particularly handsome feature although they are a little out of shape. PRICE INCLUDES WORLDWIDE POSTAGE
