The rug is beautifully drawn with superb colours, the large Tiger is on a light indigo blue field. The field is filled with many different tribal elements the most notable of which is a large horse with a headless rider. There are many birds, animals and flowers; but the main feature is the beautiful Tiger. Both ends of the rug retain the original finishes with a short kilim. The rug is in excellent condition with a fine weave and medium pile. There is some slight wear and corrosion to the blacks especially in the horse. This is a fine and light weight rug. The rug is suitable for light domestic use but would make a truly outstanding wall hanging. The rug has been hand washed and is ready for use or display. Stock Number: R-1105
