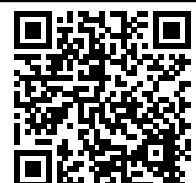

The jug has engraved decoration or foliar design with a cartouche each side. One cartouche bears the faintest remains of a monogram, but it is barely visible.
