Description

An antique South Bend full hunter pocket watch. The watch has a stem-winding movement with 17 jewels which is ticking away nicely and the time keeping is good to within around two minutes over 24 hours. The movement is signed South Bend Watch Co Ind, USA, grade number 212 and a serial number which dates it back to 1912. The movement is protected by an inner hinged cover. The watch measures 50mm diameter excluding the winding stem and the loop. The full hunter case is gold plated and it is in pretty good condition for its age with gentle indentations and surface marks. The winding crown pushes down to release the front cover. The plastic lens is in good condition. The white dial is signed with the South Bend name. Unusually as well as having the minute markers, each one is numbered. The hands are initially set by pulling out the small lever on the bezel below number 4 and turning the hands clockwise with the winding crown. The South Bend Watch Company was formed by three brothers, George, Clement and John M. Studebaker. South Bend movements were identified as model 1, 2, or 3, with grades numbering 100 to 431 ... even number grades denoted hunter-case movements s...
