Size-3.5 inches long by 1.5 inches diameter. In very good antique condition. Great to put in a tea caddy, use for sauces, or place into a collection. These were used to mix the tea leaves in the mixing bowls of a tea caddy, and then to transfer the leaves to the pot for brewing. Now, can be used for anything.
