There is the unusual action that by pulling the handle forward, an inner tray is revealed fully fitted with a total of 15 tools and implements including a silver pencil and original scissors etc. A stunning fitted dressing and jewellery case, hallmarked for London 1866, and retailed by Howell & James of Regent Street, LONDON.
