Description

A Large mahogany Early Victorian Period antique sideboard, having a raised and shaped back with a finely carved central cartouche and flame mahogany panel with acanthus carved scrolling ends, above the beautifully figured solid mahogany top. With a central serpentine ash lined frieze drawer veneered in flame mahogany veneers, flanked by twin flame veneered hinged cupboards. The right hand side opens to reveal a storage drawer and fitted cellaret. The left hand section with a storage drawer but with three ash lined sliding shelves. Having solid mahogany ends, the whole supported on a mahogany veneered plinth. The use of ash linings throughout would indicate that this sideboard is perhaps Scottish. Circa 1850-1860 Dimensions: 78" wide x 26" deep x 55" high Condition: This sideboard is in superb original condition, cleaned and waxed.
