Description

C19th William IV period mahogany knee-hole dressing or writing table. Fitted with a three-quarter surround gallery up-stand, and 2 drawers either side of a classically-inspired and crisply-carved with honeysuckle motif central 'knee-hole' panel. The waist frieze decorated with an applied gilt-brass trim, the drawers fitted with replacement cast gilt-brass period oval ring handles. Raised upon turned, tapering legs with carved detail to top and bottom, onto turned feet. In excellent original condition, the top having achieved a nicely sun-faded, mellow colour, the whole of a generally good rich patina. Minor marks and ring stains to top commensurate with age and use. Cleaned and waxed. H 30" W 39" D 20" England c.1830
