Stanhope Forbes, it opens to reveal a vast array of wonderfully finished tools and implements, many with ivory handles engraved with the owners initials, The upper tray lifts out to reveal SIX ivory rulers and many more implements, with a further half-tray below with yet more objects. Signed: Elliott & Sons (makers) and most are engraved PBSS for the owner. *Philip Bertie Spencer Stanhope (b1868) was from an eminent family of landed gentry that included artist John Stanhope and Evelyn de Morgan.
