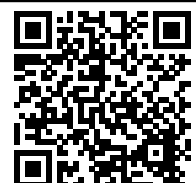
A beautiful and very decorative example of a late Victorian sterling silver bread fork, always very popular for serving all sorts of things, and particularly sought-after in sterling rather than silver plate. This one is larger than most, measuring 8" long x 2" at widest. The handle is made by exotic Mother of Pearl or Nacre shell with a bright shiny patina highlighting its iridescent qualities. The handle is joined to the sterling form with a highly decorative ferrule. The fork is beautifully decorated.
