Description

C19th George II style decorated and parcel-gilt astragal glazed bookcase. Very impressive mahogany-constructed 2-door bookcase/cabinet decorated with a period-inspired dark green and gilded scheme. Dramatically-scaled twin glazed doors with gilt-highlighted glazing bars enclosing a 5 fixed-shelf interior. The carved cavetto and 'egg and dart' cornice with parcel gilt decoration, above a dentil mould. A Chippendale-inspired 'card-cut' blind-fret frieze beneath. The plinth base carved with period-style parcel gilded flower-head design moulding. The majority of the glass panes almost certainly mid C18th, with some old replacements. In excellent aged period-style paint finish, incorporating mid C18th period doors. A practical and stylish cabinet with striking visual presence. H 82" W 58.5" D 17.5" England c.1850
