A very good quality and fine plum pudding mahogany and brass French Directoire style pedestal kneehole desk dating to circa 1850-1860. Having a rectangular top with plum pudding mahogany banded boarder with inset black and gilt tooled leather surrounded by a brass moulded edge retaining two pull out slides to either side again with a black leather insert. The top having three plum pudding mahogany frieze drawers with banded and brass moulded edge and central escutcheons sitting over two pedestals each with three graduated drawers being flanked by brass flutes. Each drawer has it own original working key plus there is one spare key and one drawer having a internal safety box with its own lock and key for valuables. This extremely attractive desk is panelled to all sides so can be used to stand freely within the center of a room. Having been constructed of the finest timbers this antique desk has a lovely mellow colour with striking veneers and is fully restored ready for use within the home.
