Description

An antique silver WW1 trench watch. The watch has a hand-winding movement which is working well. The watch measures 33mm diameter excluding the winding crown and the fixed wire lugs. The case is silver and there are hallmarks inside the hinged case back for London (import mark), 1915 with an importer's mark for George Stockwell. From 1 June 1907, Stockwells acted as assay agents, facilitating the import into Britain of foreign gold and silver items, which had to be assayed and hallmarked in a UK assay office before being released for retail. The case is in good condition with just some gentle unevenness to the case back. The lens is in good condition. The watch has a white enamel dial which has some faint hairline cracks radiating from the centre. The dial has a good look with blued steel hands, bold numbers with a red number 12 and an outer minute track. A later black leather strap has been fitted. PRICE INCLUDES WORLDWIDE POSTAGE
